Greetings Pittsburgh Chapter Members and Friends!

I compose this month's *Dean's Notes* just a few days after our January Executive Board meeting. There are several items to share from that gathering!

First, the **Chapter Nominating Committee** is beginning to assemble a slate for the upcoming Chapter elections, which will be held in early May...via mail and/or online methods! The committee is made up of Ellen Gross, Alan Lewis, and Sr. Cynthia Pock. If you are contacted, please consider serving your Chapter!

We need to have two candidates for each position up for election, which include:

**Officers**: Sub-Dean, Secretary, Treasurer, and Registrar. (Current Sub-Dean Regina Kettering has agreed to serve as Dean)

Current Officers have each served for two 2-year terms and are NOT eligible to be up for re-election with the exception of Registrar Bob Senay, who was elected in 2023 to replace me when I was promoted to Dean. Bob is choosing not to be re-nominated.

**Four Executive Board Members** for a 4-year term expiring in 2029.

From information I have, there is no term limit for members of the Executive Board, so all are eligible to be nominated for another 4-year term. (*I apologize if my information is incorrect!*)

A long discussion was held regarding the decreasing attendance at our monthly dinners and meetings. It was determined that a major reason is the ever-increasing cost of providing the meals. Because your Chapter is financially very stable, the board unanimously voted to reduce the cost of the meals for the remainder of this year, as well as for the next program year!

The difference in the costs will be absorbed by the Chapter. *The new rate will be \$20.00 per member* (and guests), and \$10.00 for Students with a Student ID. (The \$5.00 late fee will remain the same.) Please note that the few of our members who have paid for Standing Reservations will receive a refund of their over-payment!

A VERY IMPORTANT item: The new AGO Membership Database! Bob Senay has printed out a current roster for the board members. We need you to make sure that you have gone onto the database, and checked and updated (if necessary!!) your information, and make sure your dues are current! Bob will put a separate article in this issue of *Pipelines* as to how you go about doing this. Our current roster has less than 140 members – about 35 less than last year!

Finally, I look forward to hosting the next Chapter meeting at Saint John Evangelical Lutheran Church in Carnegie on Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup>. Dinner will be served at 6:30 PM, with some wine and cheese available shortly after 6:00 PM. Come and enjoy some fellowship and an interesting "Clergy and Organist Panel Discussion on The Decline of Church Membership and the Shortage of Organists for Part-Time Jobs," which will be moderated by Dr. Wayne Earnest.
